Education - Takayla's story



▲ Takayla needed extra help to stay on track in school. Her mom heard about United Way's Achievers For Life, a dropout prevention strategy, and registered her in the program. Through weekly sessions, she received one-on-one mentoring. Today, Takayla has earned a spot on the A/B Honor Roll, completed advanced classes, and qualified as a candidate for a college scholarship program.

United Way is addressing the root causes of issues in Northeast Florida.

ISSUE:

- Some children come to school struggling with abuse, hunger, homelessness and poor health due to lack of medical attention.
- Children in low-income families have elementary math and reading scores that are four to five points lower.
- Children from low-income families are twice as likely to repeat a grade and are 3.5 times as likely to drop out of school.

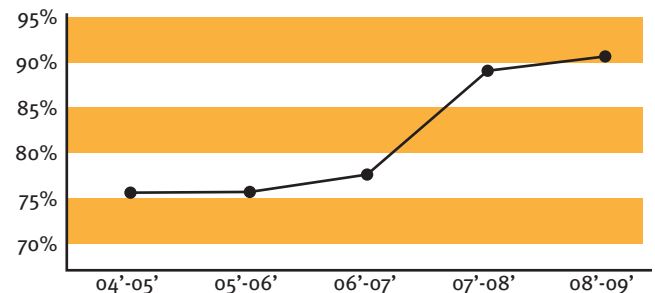
SOLUTION:

- United Way of Northeast Florida invests \$4.6 million in services to help youth succeed in life.

IMPACT:

- As a community, we have increased on-time St. Johns county high school graduations by 18% since the 2004-2005 school year.
